WORKING AT THE EXPECTED STANDARD

<i>The pupil can, after discussion with the teacher</i>							
TAF WTS	Write sentences that are sequenced to form a short narrative (real or fictional)						
TAF WTS	Demarcate some sentences with capital letters and full stops						
Y1	Use capital 'I' for the personal pronoun						
Y1	Join words and clauses using 'and'						
TAF WTS	Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling some words correctly and making phonically plausible attempts at others						
Y1	Spell many common exception words from the Year 1 list						
Y1	Add the prefix 'un' to change the meaning of a word						
Y1	Add suffixes using -ing, -ed, -er and -est, where no change is needed to the spelling of the root word						
Y1	Use -s or -es for plurals						
TAF WTS	Form many lower case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the correct place						
TAF WTS	Use spacing between words						

WORKING AT GREATER DEPTH WITHIN THE EXPECTED STANDARD

<i>The pupil can, after discussion with the teacher</i>							
TAF EXS	Write simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real or fictional)						
TAF EXS	Demarcate most sentences in their writing with capital letters and full stops, and use question marks correctly when required						
Y1	Begin to use question and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences						
Y1	Spell most common exception words correctly from the Year 1 spelling list.						
TAF EXS	Form capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower-case letters						
TAF EXS	Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters.
